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## Traffic Highlights

To maintain safety the following roads have been closed off from 900 East: Between 900-1300 S, Harvard, Princeton and Laird are closed (east and west). 1300-1700 S, Browning is closed on the west. Bryan and Logan are closed on the east.

Pedestrians can cross 900 E. on the south side of 1700 S. Work on the south side of 1300 S. is likely to begin this week and pedestrian access will be available on the north side. Please use caution when crossing the intersections.

**Traffic will switch to one lane north bound from 900 S.- 1300 S. on June 15 for the rotomill June 18-20. Asphalt pavement is scheduled June 24- 26.** Work to stripe the road, raise utilities and pour concrete collars around the manholes will continue into mid-July.

## Work in Progress (Rain permitting)

Work will begin soon between 1700 S- 2100 S.

### **Work between 900 South and 1300 South:**

- Park strip landscaping will continue between 900 S. and 1300 South.
- Side streets from 900 S-1300 S. will continue being prepped for asphalt. (Harvard, Princeton and Laird.)
- Work will continue on Red-Butte, crew will be plating it.
- Crews will be removing the asphalt (rotomilling) on June 18– June 20. **Crews will be working through the weekend** to repair soft spots in the sub-grade and prepare for asphalt paving June 24-26. We ask for your cooperation when watering to avoid water running down the street and gutter on 900 East between 900 S.-1300 S.

### **Work between 1300 South and 1700 South:**

- Storm Drain work will continue on the west side from Browning to Roosevelt and work will continue at Roosevelt and Logan (east).
- Concrete curb and gutter work will begin Sherman to Logan on west side.
- Concrete curb and gutter may continue between Browning to 1445 S, Kensington, Bryan and 1629 S and on the west side from Browning to Roosevelt and Emerson depending on storm drain work.
- Concrete removal may continue south of Harrison and then to Browning.
- Signal work will continue at 1300 S.
- Crews will be placing asphalt and working on pedestrian ramps at the 1700 S. intersection.

**Work to install the pipe and complete concrete will require temporary access restrictions to drives. If you have any special needs that may be complicated by closed driveways, please contact Christin at 1800-278-4282 or [hotline9@msn.com](mailto:hotline9@msn.com).**

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## Note

After pipe work is complete between 900 S -1300 S. Crews will begin road rehabilitation between 900 S. -1300 S. moving south (late April). Traffic will switch to 1 lane north bound. Pipe work will continue south of 1300 S.

## Utility Shutdowns

Water shut downs will occur throughout the project. Notices will be delivered to affected properties when time, date and location are determined.

## Park Strip Preservation

Excavation of the park strip is necessary for crews to continue work in the area. Crews will work to maintain the existing park strip and restore it back to its original state. If you have items in the park strip you wish to pre-serve, please remove them before excavation begins.

## Garbage Collection

To allow for garbage collection and maintain safety during construction in your area, please place garbage cans **On top of the curb and** crews will get them to the collection trucks.

If your garbage cans are missed, please call or email Christin and she will contact City sanitation (contact information below). They are happy to come back and get the missed cans, but it may take a couple days. Please have patience. We will make sure your garbage is taken care of.

*Asphalt throughout the project is temporary and will be removed and replaced with permanent asphalt at a later date.*

## Anticipated Project Schedule (schedule is subject to change)

900 S.-2100 S. *winter* irrigation utility work: November 2008– April 13, 2009

900 S.-2100 S. irrigation and utility work: April 1– September. Curb work will be done as schedule and crew availability permits.

**Street rehabilitation:** traffic in the phase will be reduced to one lane north bound.

900 South– 1300 South: *March-June*

1300 South– 1700 South: *May-August*

1700 South– 2100 South: *July- October*.

**Project clean up and punch list 900 S.– 2100 S.: July– winter 2009.**
